The Barcode Table is a dining table and also a conference table. It can be recycled by 100% due to its basic materials stone and steel. The concept of sustainability is the basis of this design as the stones from the production process are used as resource. Every Barcode Table is unique. The tabletop can be supplied in many different combinations. Naturally, the individual selection of the stone types is limited, and availability must be checked by enquiry.

Furniture as expression of the individual personality is furniture which has been hand-crafted. Each table, each chair, each product from the DRAENERT manufactory is a piece of art – and expression of its owner's personality.

Eco-friendly and resource-preserving products are strongly in demand – particularly when they are beautifully designed. The term „Green Design“ includes products of completely different areas of life and moreover completely different aspects of the eco-friendly and sustainable design. It was in that spirit, that the BARCODE table was created.

The table of stone and steel won the GREEN GOOD DESIGN AWARD of the Athenaeum Chicago (museum for architecture) in 2012 thanks to its sustainability.

The vanguard look is a result of the manufacturing process: stone fragments are newly assembled to a harmonious unity. The BARCODE table is both – a dining and a conference table. This composition, selected among 150 different stone types with diverse characteristics, requires comprehensive know how. Our expert master stonemasons assemble, ground and polish the fragments until the table becomes a monolithic object. As stones from the production process are used, a lasting handling of the material natural stone is ensured and makes this material available for the following generations. Each BARCODE table is a unique piece. Of course, the individual selection of the stone types is limited, and availability should be checked beforehand.
